### Class Photo-Taking

The school will be holding class photo-taking on 17 and 18 August. Classes will be scheduled and students are to wear their school uniform or PE attire based on that day's time-table.

Due to the current Covid-19 situation, the students' photographs will be taken in groups of 5 at a time. They will be positioned 1m apart. Students will be asked to remove their masks only when their photographs are taken and they will hold on to their masks. Students will be told to put on their masks immediately after their photo is taken. The duration will be less than 2 – 3 minutes per group of 5 students. The school will ensure that safe distancing measures are observed.
