




MK CURRICULUM

Based on the beliefs and principles in the Nurturing Early Learners Framework, developed by MOE, to guide quality kindergarten teaching and learning of children in Singapore








MK CURRICULUM DESIGN PRINCIPLES

- Learning through quality interactions & purposeful play








MK CURRICULUM

- Weeks of Wonder (WoW) projects which encourage self-motivated learning through exploration and discovery








MK HI-LIGHT PROGRAMME

The HI-Light Programme is designed to support the holistic development of children by nurturing in them values, social and emotional skills and learning dispositions, as well as knowledge and skills across the following five learning areas through an

integrated approach:

1. Aesthetics and creative expression

- 2. Discovery of the world
- 3. Health, safety and motor skills development
- 4. Language and literacy
- 5. Numeracy













MK STARLIGHT LITERACY PROGRAMME

- Nurtures early childhood bilingualism
- Offered in English and three Mother Tongue Languages (Chinese, Malay and Tamil)
- Focuses on developing a positive disposition to the languages, listening, speaking and early reading and writing skills
- Uses Big Books, songs and games set in the local context to make learning fun & engaging
- Encourages families to be involved in activities to enthuse children in language learning
- Provides opportunities for children to communicate in English & their Mother Tongue Language with confidence and be aware of local traditions and customs





MK LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

- Creative use of available space to encourage children to discover and explore their surroundings
- Safe and & inviting indoor and & outdoor spaces
- Promotes learning through a variety of play, hands-on and interactive learning activities that are facilitated by the teachers
- Children spend at least 30 minutes outdoors daily
