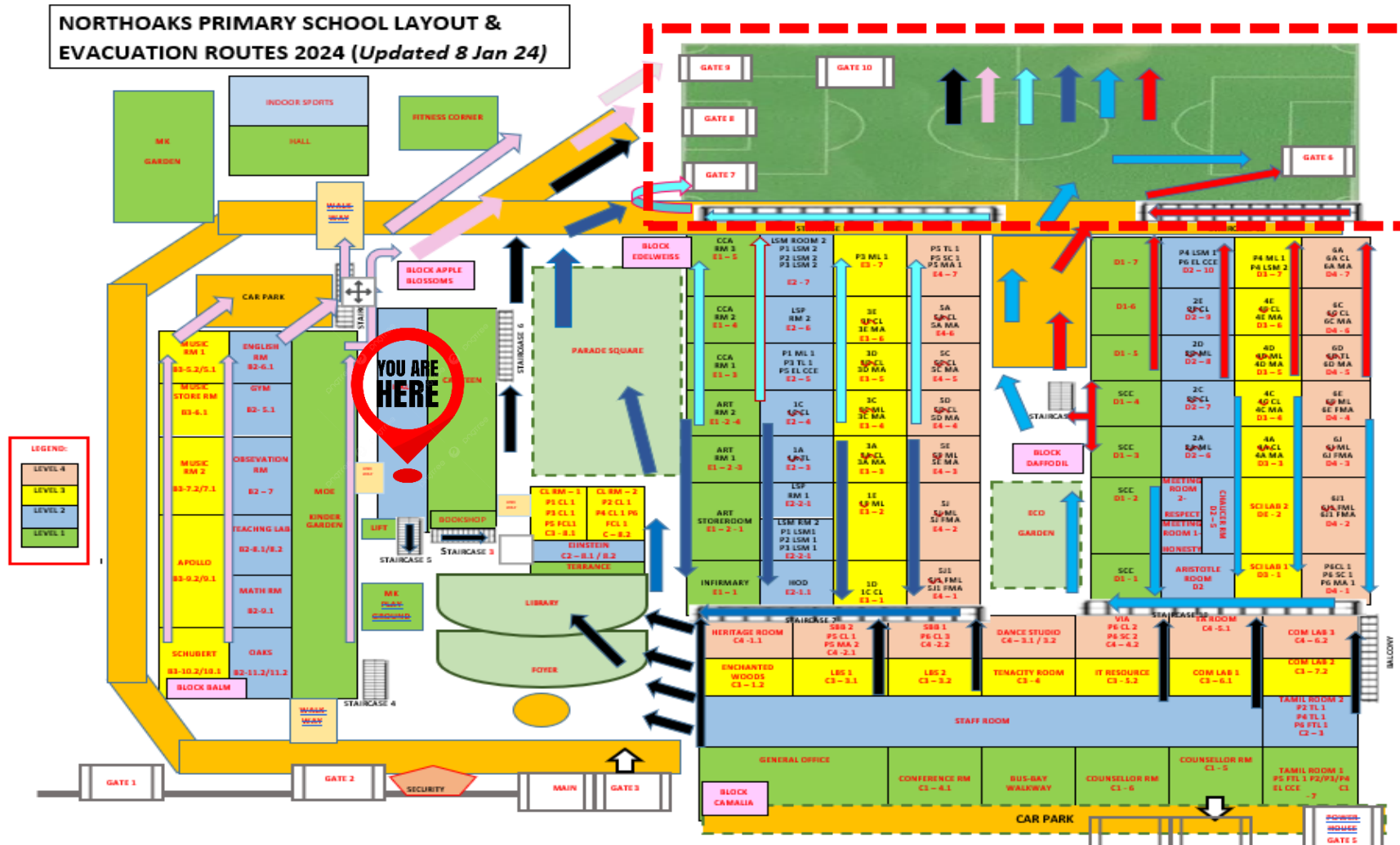

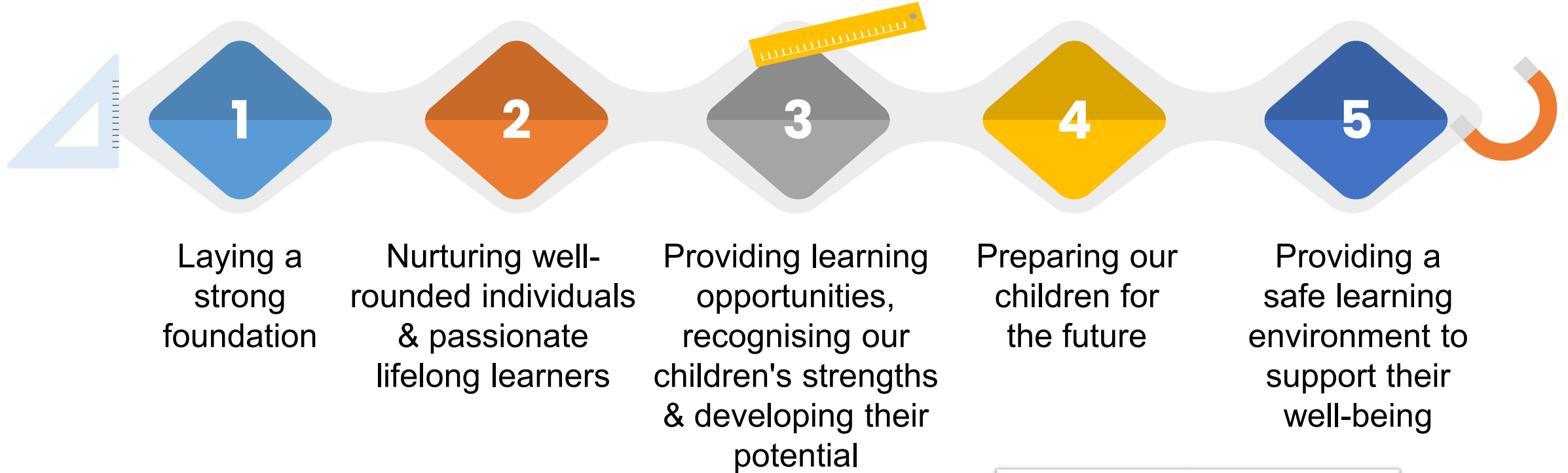
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What is Primary School about?

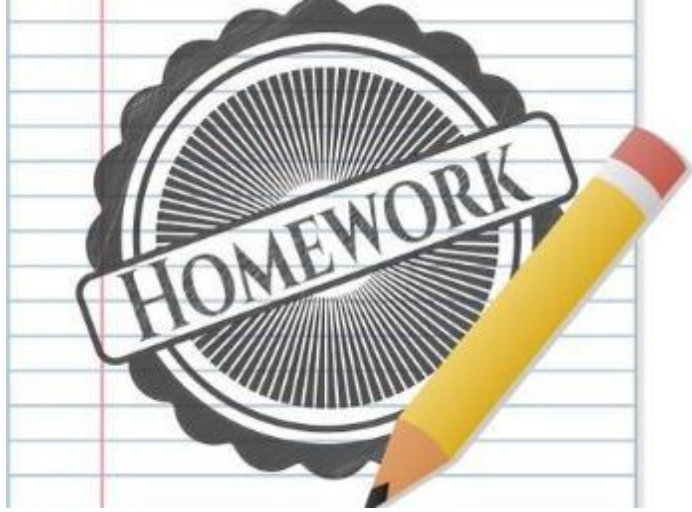


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Learning in school and at home

 *SLS onboarding information will be shared with parents via PG announcement by school.*

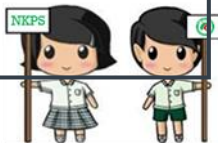
What is SLS?

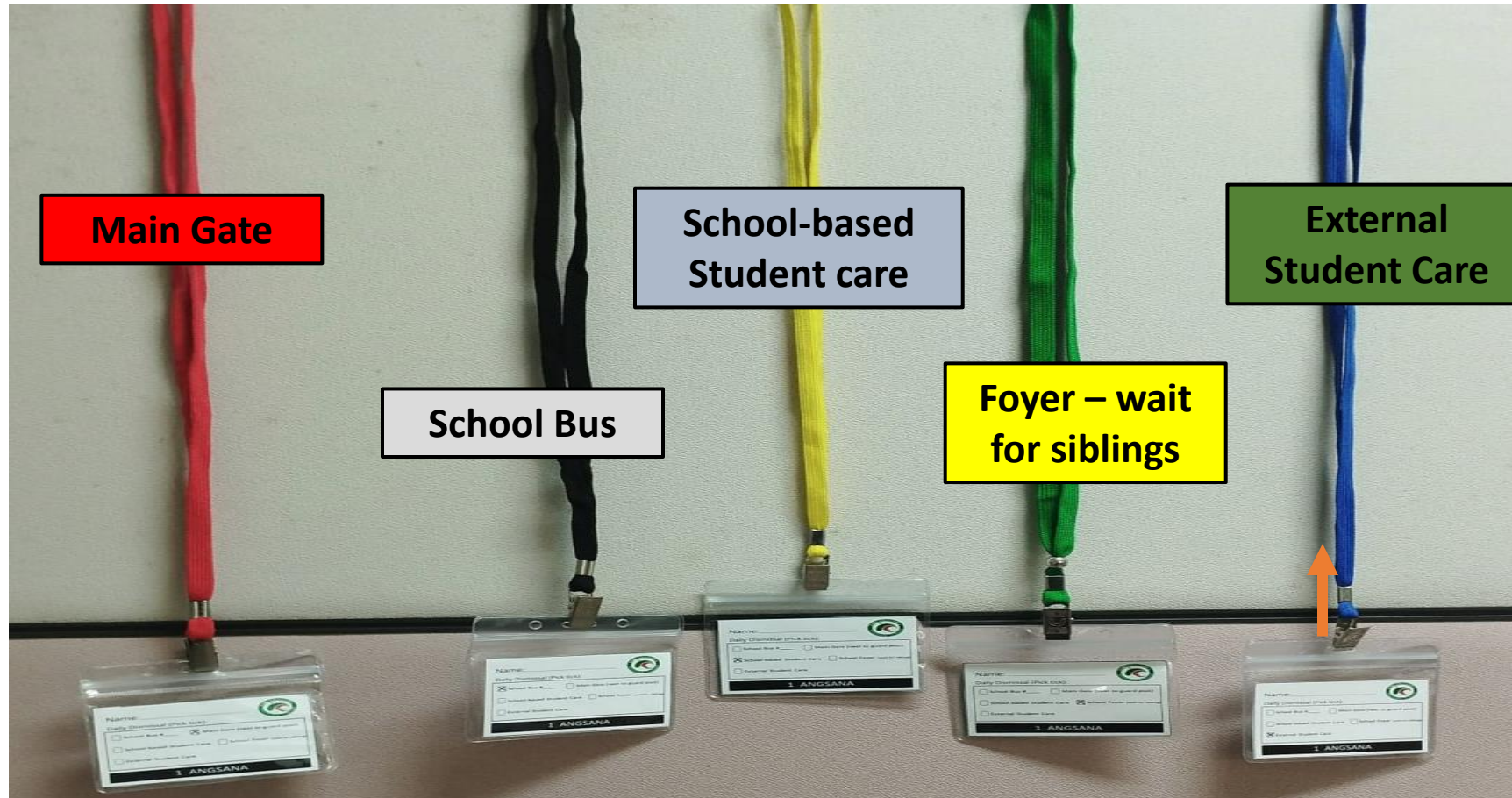

- Students must have their name tags on their P.E. attire. The name tag should be sewn above the school badge on all P.E. T-shirts.



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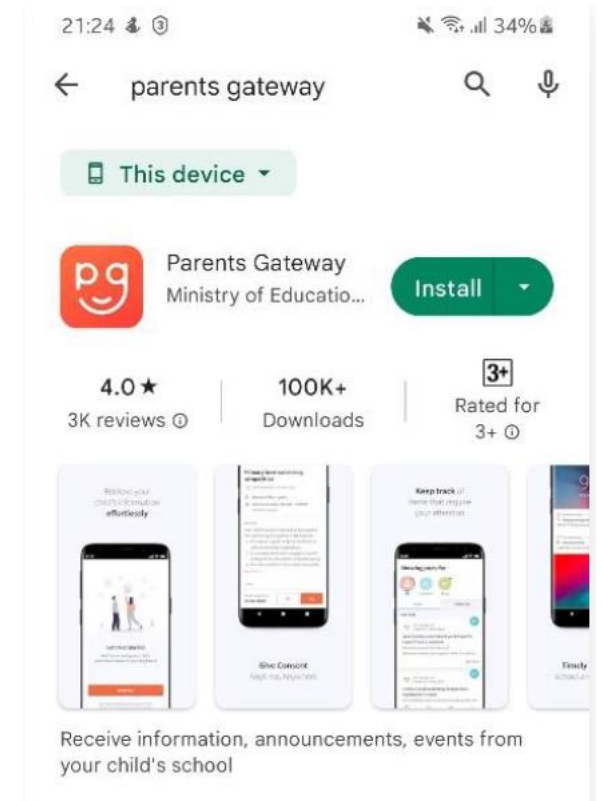
