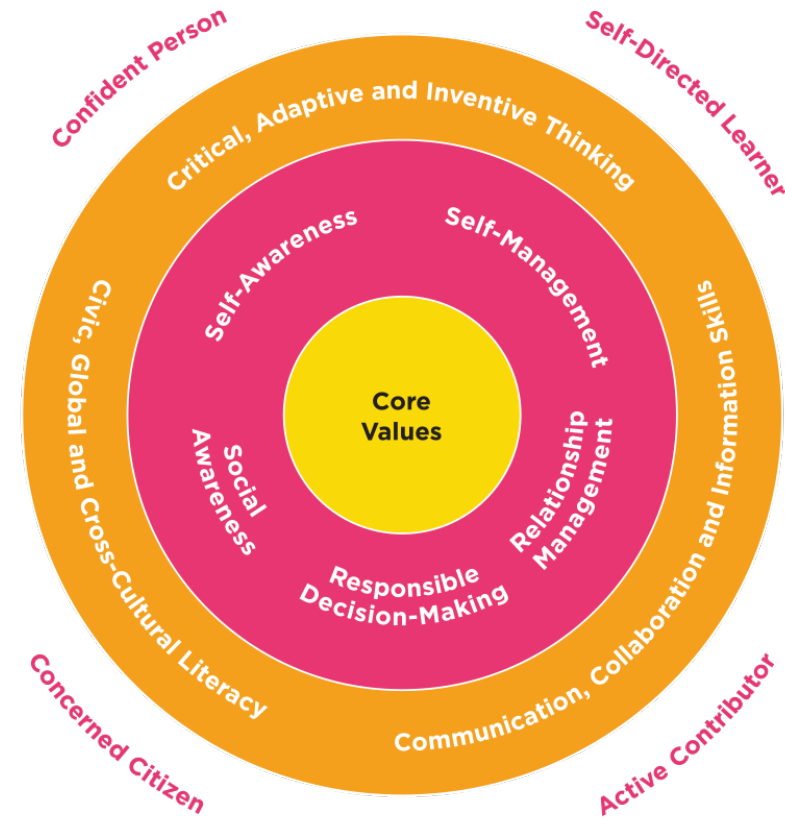

between schools and educators**



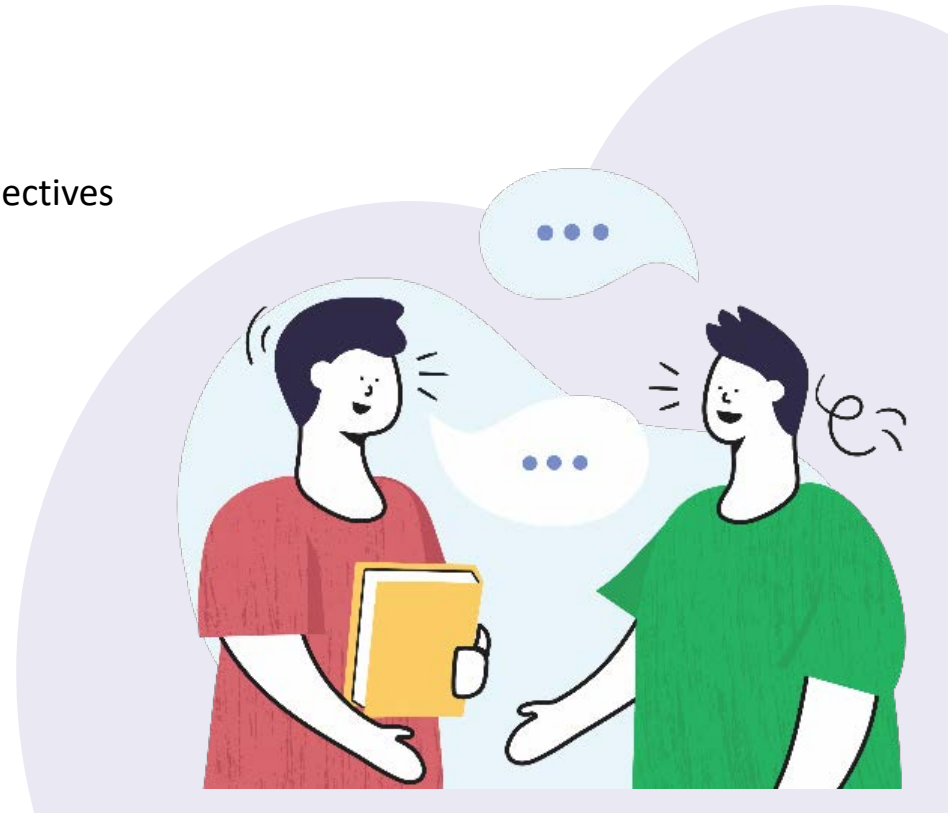
Listen to and understand each other's perspectives and concerns regarding each child

Model good values in words and actions



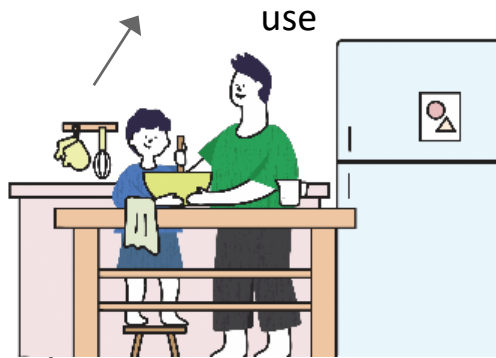
