Dear Parents/Guardians,

Enrichment Programmes for 2018 - Primary 2

In line with our school's efforts to provide quality learning for our students, we have planned several programmes to enrich your child/ward's learning experiences this year. The intent is to expose your child/ward to different domains of learning as part of the holistic development of your child/ward. As these programmes are subsidised by the school, we strongly encourage you to support your child's/ward's participation. You may wish to refer to the attached for the list of enrichment programmes for your reference.

For Singapore Citizen students, payment for these programmes will be deducted from your child's Edusave account. If the Edusave funds are insufficient, the balance will have to be paid in cash/cheque.

For non-Singaporean students, payment for the enrichment programmes will need to be paid in cash/cheque to the school.

Please do not make any payment yet. The school will generate a school bill (similar to MOE bill) in early February, indicating the amount payable from your child/ward's Edusave account (for Singapore Citizen students) or your designated GIRO account (for non-Singaporean students). The deduction will be made on **15 February 2018**.

Should there be insufficient fund, the school will generate another school bill in mid-March for the outstanding balance to be settled in cash/cheque.

Information on Enrichment Programmes

1. “The Leader in Me™” Programme

Based on The 7 Habits of Highly Effective People, our school hopes that “The Leader in Me™” Programme will help every Northoaks student to build self-confidence and develop personal management and social skills so that every child can be a leader in his/her own realm. Besides learning about socio-emotional skills during PAL lessons, students will also learn about the 7 Habits to equip them for the 21st century.

2. Mother Tongue Enrichment Programmes

CL Enrichment : KuaiBan (Clapper Talk)

This programme aims to equip students with literary skills where ideas and feelings, accentuated with the use of distinctive style and rhythm is delivered through speaking activities.

Given the exposure to rhyming poetry, students should be able to acquire skills in voice projection and body language at the end of the programme. They should also be able to develop confidence in performing in front of the audience.

ML & TL Enrichment: Musical Drama

This programme aims to equip students with literary skills where ideas and feelings are emphasized and illustrated through drama. Students are given the exposure to structures and modes of drama. The programme also aims to provide opportunities for creativity with the emphasis on sound effects.

At the end of the programme, students should be able to apply the skills in voice projection and body language. They should also be able to develop confidence in putting up a drama in front of an audience.

3. Sports Education Programme: Basic Inline Skating

The aim of the programme is to introduce inline skating to students by developing their basic fundamental skills (eg. balancing, edging, v-walk, ready roll, stopping) in a fun and safe way. Students will be taught the safety procedures such as putting on the knee pads, elbow guards, wrist guards, helmet and skates.

By instilling a safe and positive learning environment for all students, it will help develop a strong team spirit, confidence, resilience, responsibility and a great sense of pride. Students will be guided and supervised by qualified and experienced instructors.
