CURRICULUM MATTERS

University of New South Wales International Competitions and Assessments for Schools (UNSW ICAS)

We are offering the opportunity for your child/ ward to participate in the University of New South Wales International Competitions and Assessments for Schools (ICAS). The competitions are open to all Primary 3 and Primary 4 students this year. These competitions are in the form of written tests and are sat in various subjects by thousands of children in New Zealand, Australia and Asia.

Students will obtain a measure of their own achievement in an external assessment situation and be recognised and awarded achievements at all levels. Participants will receive a certificate and a detailed report highlighting their strengths and areas for improvement. Your child/ ward's participation in the competitions is **optional**.

Competition Dates and Fees

The dates and fees of the competitions are as stated in the table below. Please note that the competitions will be conducted <u>after school in the afternoon (details will be released later to participating students)</u>. As the dates for the sitting of the competitions are fixed under the ICAS regulation, no student will be allowed to sit for any competitions after the stipulated dates. Thus, no refund will be made if your child/ward misses the competition.

Young Scientist Badge Scheme

As part of the school's Science curriculum to stimulate interest in the subject and promote self-directed learning, all Primary 3 and 4 students are strongly encouraged to participate in the Young Scientist Badge Scheme in 2017. The teachers will go through some of the activities in the Young Scientist Card to earn the stars and parents may also help their child complete other activities. Students may purchase the Young Science Card in the following Science disciplines and have the opportunities to develop initiative and creativity by completing the activities stipulated in the card.

Level	Title of Young Scientist Card	Cost
Primary 3	Young Zoologist Card	\$2.50
Primary 4	Young Botanist Card	\$2.50

In guiding students' understanding and completion of the activities, Science teachers will provide advice and feedback as to how they can complete the activities well. Students will need to complete activities that are worth at least 15 stars and submit their completed cards to their Science teachers for acknowledgement. This has to be done by 14 July 2017 so that students will be awarded the Young Scientist Badge. This is also an opportune time for parent-child bonding as parents may also participate in this scheme by acknowledging the completion of up to 6 stars worth of activities and/or working with your child on some of the activities.
