## **School Smart Cards for Primary 1 Students**

The School Smart Cards (SCC) will be issued to Primary 1 students this week. To start using the SSC for concessionary travel, students are required to activate the card at the TransitLink Ticket Office/TransitLink Concession Card Replacement Office/Passenger Services Centre located in the MRT Stations/Bus Interchanges by topping-up the value for the card. In support of national initiative to steer commuters towards adopting e-payments in transit ticketing, top up at Passenger Services Centre (PSC) is progressively ceased. However, PSCs will continue to assist in the activation of concession card for MOE students. To avoid being turned away, students are advised to inform the PSC staff that they would like to activate their concession card. The minimum top-up value is \$5.

Please also check the photo and details printed on the card, and inform the school immediately for any discrepancy.
