CURRICULUM MATTERS

Holistic Assessment for Primary 1

As in semester 1, there will be no examinations for Primary 1 this semester. Assessment will be conducted in bite-size to assess students' level of understanding and to assess them holistically. Please refer to the attachment for details of the assessment plan for Semester 2.

Holistic Assessment and Semestral Assessment 2 (SA2) for Primary 2

Holistic Assessment will continue to be conducted in Term 3. All Primary 2 students will sit for the formal SA2 examinations in Term 4. Please refer to the attachment for details of the assessment plan for Semester 2.

Assessment for Primary 3, Primary 4 and Primary 5

There will be no Continual Assessments (CA) for the Primary 3, 4 and 5 students in Term 3, instead tests / performance tasks will be conducted for them. In Term 4, all Primary 3, 4 and 5 students will sit for the formal SA2 examination. Please refer to the attachment for details of the assessment plans for Semester 2.

Gifted Education Programme (GEP) Identification Exercise 2018 for Primary 3 Students

The GEP Identification Exercise aims to identify suitable students with high intellectual potential. Test-preparation activities could inflate students' scores and not reflect their actual potential. Students who are not ready to handle the intellectual rigour and demands of the programme will struggle with the enriched curriculum and not benefit fully from it.
