Home-Based Learning

As the students will not need to be in school during the PSLE Marking Exercise, 15 Oct to 18 Oct, the school has arranged for learning to take place at home. The objective of this home-based learning is to engage the students meaningfully in their continual revision during the 4-day school break. We hope to promote self-directed learning among the students.

Students should try to log into the various learning portals at home. They should inform their respective teachers if their accounts have been locked out or if they have forgotten their passwords by **Thursday, 11 October 2018**. During the home-based learning days, teachers will not be available to assist with the log-in issues as they will be involved in PSLE marking.

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Instruction Guide to Access the MC Online Portal

1. Logging In

To login and access MC Online LMS portal, go to www.mconline.sg

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2. Accessing Assignments

3. Click on the title of the assignment to launch the lesson or test viewer to complete the assignment.
 - a. For lessons, there is no "SUBMIT" button as submission is not required. These are automatically tracked.
 - b. For tests, you will have to click on a "SUBMIT" button at the end of every test.
